Remember Act 2...

“All gathered together in one place”...

People from throughout the world have moved to Texas with over 92 different language groups represented in the Houston area. The Texas District has a goal of ordaining as many men as possible to become pastors from the culture groups to serve in ministry to their respective cultural backgrounds. God has already given us missionaries in Texas from many of these cultural backgrounds.

“All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit”...

Men and women have been touched by the Holy Spirit to lead the outreach mission of Christ’s saving message.

“They began to speak in tongues as the Spirit enabled them”...

At least 15 languages are spoken by the missionaries in our Texas District.

“Peter raised his voice and spoke”...

Over 90 missionaries are sharing their faith with people from many cultures right here in Texas.

“Brothers what shall we do?”...

This cry from the people hearing the disciples is being heard today by our missionaries. The answer is still the same: repent and be baptized! Classes in English as a second language have developed into Bible study groups, which in turn have developed into the beginning stages of new congregations.
